We are pleased that you are interested in joining AmeriCorps Seniors as a volunteer in the Foster Grandparent Program (FGP), sponsored by The Evelyn Rubenstein Jewish Community Center of Houston. FGP is a wonderful intergenerational program that provides older adults with the opportunity to nurture children with special and exceptional needs. In order to be eligible for the program, AmeriCorps Seniors volunteers with FGP must:

- Be at least 55 years of age
- Pass a background check & FBI fingerprint screening
- Not exceed total household annual income of \$27,180 (one person household), or \$36,620 (two-person household)
- Be available to volunteer between September – May (as most of our placements operate on a school-year calendar)

Enclosed is our Intake Form, Emergency Contacts/CIMA Insurance Beneficiaries Form. Please complete both forms & return them to us as soon as possible. **Once we receive your completed documents, we will schedule an in-person interview with you at our office.** When you arrive for the interview, please bring:

- A copy of your 2023 Social Security Award Letter
- Proof of any other income (ex: pension, etc.)
- Driver's license or State I.D.
- Proof of auto insurance
